Applicant is requesting a variance to Municipal Code Section 225, Schedule II – Height, Lot, Yard and Bulk Regulations

Applicant is requesting permission to reduce a side yard setback to erect a garage. Applicant is asking for a 1.6' side yard setback. The code stipulates a minimum side yard setback of 8'.

APPEARANCE: Bill Riter

DISCUSSION: Bill explained that his garage is the original and is asking to make it larger. The Board had no questions for the applicant.

The Chairman asked three times if there was anyone in the audience who would like to speak in favor of granting the variance. Matthew Hartung of 105 Thorn spoke in favor of granting the variance stating it was an improvement to the neighborhood.

The Chairman asked three times if there was anyone in the audience who would like to speak against granting the variance. There were none.

The Chairman then asked if the Secretary had received any communications either for, or against, granting the variance. The Planning Board gave a positive referral to grant the variance. A phone call was received from Jim Higgins of 68 Argyle on 8/18/20 stating that the Riter's have done nothing but improve their property and he has no problem with the variance request. A call was also received from Steve Lasker of 60 Argyle on 8/24/20 stating he is unable to make the meeting but has no problem with the variance request.

Kevin Moran made a motion, seconded by Gary Phillips in favor of granting permission to reduce the side yard set back to erect a garage with a side yard setback of 1.6' at 119 S Lincoln Avenue SBL #173.05-1-40.
