Moved by Trustee Pyne, seconded by Trustee Hartung that the following Local Law of 2022 be adopted, amending Chapter 187 of the Village of Orchard Park Code entitled “Streets and Sidewalks”:

SECTION 1: Amending Chapter 187, Streets and Sidewalks as follows:

§ 187-1 Permit required, fees; restoration

A. Replace the word “Director” with the word “Manager”.

B. To read:

Fees to be paid. The Manager of Public Works shall not issue any permit to excavate in any public street without the payment of fees as established in the fee schedule, Chapter A232 of the Code of the Village of Orchard Park.

§ 187-2 **Special provisions pertaining to public service corporations.**

- A. Replace the word “Director” with the word “Manager”.
- C. (1) Replace the word “Director” with the word “Manager”.
- C. (2) Replace the word “Director” with the word “Manager”.

§ 187-3. **Driveways; drainage ditches.**

- A. Replace the word “Director” with the word “Manager”.

§ 187-5 **Hindering or obstructing construction prohibited.**

Replace the word “Director” with the word “Manager”.

§ 187-6 **Storage of material on streets.**

Replace the word “Director” with the word “Manager”.

§ 187-8 **Excavations near street lines.**

Replace the word “Director” with the word “Manager”.

SECTION 2: EFFECTIVE DATE: This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
